

Report of Yellowknife Regional Roundtable on Employer Investment in Workplace Learning

What can we do to encourage greater employer investment in workplace learning?

The Canadian Council on Learning's Work and Learning Knowledge Centre (WLKC), an initiative co-led by Canadian Manufacturers & Exporters and the Canadian Labour Congress, has just released the report of its [Yellowknife Regional Roundtable on Employer Investment in Workplace Learning](#).

The May 20, 2008 Yellowknife roundtable — part of a cross-country initiative organized in partnership with Canadian Policy Research Networks — brought together senior representatives from government, business, labour, colleges, universities and the community sector. This high-level group assessed major skills and training challenges facing the Northwest Territories and discussed some of the “best bets” for moving forward to address these challenges.
