PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE: Recognize outstanding students for their excellence and professionalism in the esthetics industry.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

Independently demonstrate the knowledge and ability of the mastery of esthetics in the following areas:

- Specific Care Facial
- Basic Manicure with matte red polish
- Basic Pedicure with matte red polish

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

Competitor Must Provide: White uniform, shoes and hose (no open toed shoes)

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES:

List of supplies needed is under each category

JUDGING CRITERIA:

- Client professionalism:
- Competitors must smile and greet models
- Ensure clients comfort
- No talking during any part of the competition unless required ensuring client comfort or to ask a question or answer a question by the judges.

SANITATION:

- Clean and sanitize work area, including all equipment and implements.
- Garbage's are to be empty and discarded after each competition. Wash and sanitize hands before and after each competition. (In case of no sink available, bring hand sanitizer)
- Gloves are optional in the competition.

COMPETITORS PROFESSIONAL IMAGE:

- Makeup:** Suitable for daytime
- Hair:** tied back if length allows, otherwise kept back from face.
- Clothing:** White professional uniform, shoes, and hose. (Shoes must not be opened toed, and a low or non heel, no slip shoe must be worn)
- Nails:** neatly manicured (No artificial nails or nail polish for sanitary reasons)
- Jewelry:** Not to be worn throughout the competition including any visible piercings.
- Personal Hygiene:** No perfumes are to be worn throughout the competition

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

Orientation will begin at 8:30 to 9:00AM, FRIDAY, April 16th 2010. All competitors are to bring all equipment to Woodland Campus, Prince Albert SK.

All competitors must be currently enrolled in an Esthetics program or have graduated within one calendar year of competition. No school or professional logos are to be displayed at any time throughout competition. Competitors must supply models (models cannot be Estheticians or Estheticians in training).

MANICURE WITH RED POLISH

OBJECTIVE: To perform a basic manicure. Examine hands and fingernails, shape free edge according to shape of nail plate. Apply base coat, 2 coats of matte red polish and topcoat with no color bleeding.

ITEMS TO BE SUPPLIED BY COMPETITOR:

FINGER BOWL	CUTICLE SOLVENT	CUTICLE PUSHER
CUTICLE OIL	MASSAGE LOTION	ALCOHOL
ORANGEWOOD STICKS	EMERY BOARD	TOWELS
MATTE RED POLISH	BASE COAT	COTTON
TOP COAT	GLOVES	

OVERALL GRADING:

Professionalism

Sanitation (dispose of any orangewood sticks etc)

Functional Setup

Client Comfort

Proper Manicure procedure (soaking, push back cuticles, etc.)

File nails into correct shape to models hands

Polish 2 coats matte red polish including topcoat and base coat. No excess polish left around cuticle or sidewall areas. No polish cleanup allowed until grading has been completed on polish application by the judges. After the grading has been completed, the competitor may fix any polish corrections necessary.

Promptness

1 HOUR TO COMPLETE

PEDICURE

OBJECTIVE: to perform a complete pedicure removing callus and dry areas, proper shaping of toenails and cuticle care.

ITEMS TO BE SUPPLIED BY COMPETITOR

OVERALL GRADING:

Professionalism

Sanitation

Proper pedicure procedure (soaking, push back cuticles, etc.)

Toenail shaping, clean under free edge.

Massage (pressure, duration and speed)

Polish application (base coat, two coats of matte red polish, and top coat)

No excess polish on cuticle or sidewalls.

Polish remover only allowed after massage to remove excess oil of nail plate. No polish cleanup allowed until grading has been completed on polish application by the judges.

After the grading has been completed, the competitor may fix any polish corrections necessary.

Promptness

1 HOUR AND 30 MINUTES TO COMPLETE

BASIC FACIAL WITHOUT MACHINES

OBJECTIVE: Perform a basic facial on a female model. Record skin analysis on technical chart. Select products suitable to models skin type.
