EVENT: AESTHETICS	LEVEL: SECONDARY
START TIME: 8:30 AM, March 16, 2012	LOCATION: Marvel Beauty School
INTERNATIONAL TRADE #: 43	DURATION: 5 HRS.

PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE: to evaluate each competitor on the knowledge of basic aesthetics. This is in preparation for further education in a beauty school.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED: Independently demonstrate the knowledge of basic aesthetics. In addition, present professionalism throughout each task.

Competitor Must Provide:

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS: White lab coat or professional white uniform is to be worn throughout entire competition. Clothing worn under lab coat must remain professional. No school logos are to be displayed throughout any part of the competition. Vinyl or Latex gloves are optional throughout manicure and pedicure portion of competition. All competitors must wear white, non-slip, flat or low heel closed toe shoes.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Client Professionalism

Competitors must smile and greet models.

Ensure models comfort throughout whole competition.

No talking during any procedure unless to ensure client comfort.

Sanitation

Clean and sanitize work area, including all equipment and supplies.

Garbage bags are to be emptied and discarded each competition. Wash hands before and after each practical exam. (Sink may not be available. Must use alcohol or hand sanitizer)

Competitor's professional image:

Makeup: Suitable for daytime.

Hair: tied back if length allows, otherwise kept back from face.

Clothing: White professional uniform or white lab coat with professional clothing underneath, white shoes and white hose. (Shoes may not be opened toed and must be non slip and low or no heel.)

Nails: neatly manicured and no nail polish. (No artificial nails for sanitary reasons.)

Jewelry: None is to be worn throughout competition -visible facial piercing must not interfere with client treatment.

Personal Hygiene: No perfumes to be worn throughout competition.

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES, CLOTHING:

List is provided for each competition

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

Orientation will begin at 8:30 to 9:00AM, FRIDAY, MARCH 16. All competitors are to bring all equipment to the determined location and set up area after the orientation.

-All competitors must currently be enrolled in the aesthetics program.

-Competitors must supply own models for entire competition.

-Models may not be certified estheticians or estheticians in training.

MANICURE INCLUDING MASSAGE

OBJECTIVE: to perform a basic manicure with massage. Apply base coat, two coats of matte red polish and top coat with no color on cuticle area.

OVERALL GRADING:

Professionalism

Client Comfort

Verbal consultation with client and judges

Sanitation: proper disposal of any orangewood sticks, cotton, garbage etc, cleaning of implements, hands etc.

Functional Setup

Correct procedures following *Milady Textbook procedure*

Proper manicure procedure (soaking, push back cuticles, massage etc)

File nails into correct shape to models hands

Polish 1 coat base 2 coats colored polish and one top coat. No excess polish left around cuticle or side wall areas.

Promptness

Nail Polish remover is to be used only after massage to remove traces of oil from nail plate. It cannot be used for cleanup of polish until grading of polish has been completed by the judges. After grading has been completed the competitor will fix any polish corrections needed.

No cuticle nippers to be used for Secondary Estheticians.

All judging will be based on the Milady Manicure Textbook procedures.

1 HOUR TO COMPLETE

PEDICURE

OBJECTIVE: to perform a complete pedicure removing callus and dry areas, proper shaping of toenails and cuticle care.

OVERALL GRADING:

Professionalism
Verbal Consultation with client and judges
Sanitation

Proper pedicure procedure (soaking, push back cuticles, etc.)

Toenail shaping, clean under free edge.

Massage (pressure, duration and speed)

Polish application (base coat, two coats of matte red polish, and top coat)

No excess polish on cuticle or sidewalls.

Polish remover only allowed after massage to remove excess oil of nail plate. No polish cleanup allowed until grading has been completed on polish application by the judges. After the grading has been completed, the competitor will fix any polish corrections necessary.

Promptness

All judging will be based on the Milady Textbook procedures of a basic pedicure.

1 HOUR AND 15 MINUTES TO COMPLETE

FANTASY MAKEUP APPLICATION:

OBJECTIVE: applying creativity to your knowledge of makeup artistry. Full Basic makeup must be applied to model. In addition fantasy makeup applied to focus area.

Note: molding wax or latex is not to be used in this competition
