SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

Competitor Must Provide:

White professional uniform, white professional shoes, white hose

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES:

List of equipment to be supplied by competitors under each competition heading.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Client Professionalism

Competitors must smile and greet models.

Ensure models comfort.

No talking during any procedure.

Sanitation

Clean and sanitize work are, including all equipment and implements.

Garages are to be emptied.

Wash and sanitize hands before each practical exam.

Competitors professional Image

Makeup: Suitable for daytime

Hair: Firming tied back if length allows, otherwise back away from face.

Clothing: White uniform, white shoes and hose.

Nails: Neatly manicured, no artificial nails for sanitary reasons.

Jewelry: None.

Personal Hygiene: No odor or perfumes.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- All competitors must currently be enrolled in the esthetics' program.
- No school logos are to be displayed throughout any part of the competition.
- Competitors must supply own models for entire competition except facial without machines, in which models will be provided.
- Models may not be certified estheticians or estheticians in training.

All competitors must receive a registration package with a randomly selected number. Competitors are to wear these, as it will be used to identify you throughout the competition

Orientation will begin at 7:30 to 8:00 at the competition site on March 25. All competitors are to bring all equipment to room E210 and choose set up area. Wax pots are to be plugged in night of registration.

Basic Manicure with Red Polish

Objective: To perform a basic manicure. Examine hands and fingernails, shape free edge to nail plate shape. Apply base coat and two coats of red polish and topcoat with no color bleeding.

Items to be supplied by competitor:

Fingerbowl	cuticle solvent
Cuticle pusher	cuticle oil
Cuticle nippers	massage lotion
Orangewood sticks	nail polish remover
Emery boards	Alcohol
Block buffer	base coat
Towels	matte red polish
Cotton	Top coat

Overall Grading:

Professionalism

Sanitation (dispose any orangewood sticks etc.)
(Sanitize any metal implements)

File nails into correct shape to models hands.

Polish 2 coats matte red polish in 3 stroke method.

Time to complete 1 hr

Hot and Warm Waxing Competition:

Objective: To completely wax lower legs and underarms using two methods of waxing. Ensuring no hair or wax residue left behind. No tweezing will be allowed in this portion of this competition. When waxing danger disease transmission, therefore gloves are to be worn.

Items to be supplied by competitors:

Hot and Warm wax	Bed paper
Wax pots	Client Robe/ Wrap
Wax strips	Cleansing Lotion
Gloves	Soothing Cream
Spatula/ Applicator	Pre epilating powder

Overall Grading:

Professionalism.
Sanitation (dispose wax strips/bed paper/ gloves etc.)
Checked temperature of wax
Direction of hair growth followed.
No hair remaining
No wax residue remaining
No tweezing

Basic Facial without Machines

Objective: do a basic facial on a supplied female model. Record skin analysis on technical chart. Select products to be suitable to models skin type. Clean and tidy work station.

Items to be supplied by competitor:

Spatula

Client robe/ wrap

Bed linen

Thermal Blanket

Towels (for steaming, large towel to cover clients hair)

Magnifying lamp

Facial sponges / rinse bowl

Mask brush

Facial Brush

Eye pads

Comodone Extractor

Clip board (to fill out charts)

Note All facial product for the competition will be supplied by France Laure.

Overall Grading:

Professionalism

Sanitation

Skin analysis (visual/touch/magnifying glass)

No talking

Correct product selection (suitable to skin type)

Technical chart filled out correctly.

Skin Analysis of models will be done before hand by judges.

Objective: Apply evening makeup, including highlight and shadowing for models face shape.
