SAFETY REQUIREMENTS: Competitors are required to follow all industry safety standards during the competition. Including all sanitation procedures.

PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE:

To evaluate each competitor's knowledge of basic esthetics. In preparation for further education in beauty school.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

Independently demonstrate the knowledge of basic esthetics.

THEORY EXAM:

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

White lab coat to be worn throughout entire competition.

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Client Professionalism

Competitors must smile and greet models.

Ensure models comfort.

No talking during any procedure.

Sanitation

Clean and sanitize work are, including all equipment and implements.

Garages are to be emptied.

Wash and sanitize hands before each practical exam.

Competitors professional Image

Makeup: Suitable for daytime

Hair: Firming tied back if length allows, otherwise back away from face.

Clothing: White uniform, white shoes and hose.

Nails: Neatly manicured, no artificial nails for sanitary reasons.

Jewelry: None.

Personal Hygiene: No odor or perfumes.

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

- All competitors must currently be enrolled in the esthetics' program.
- No school logos are to be displayed throughout any part of the competition.
- Competitors must supply own models for entire competition.
- Models may not be certified estheticians or estheticians in training.

Orientation will begin at 7:30 to 8:00 at the competition site on March 25. All competitors are to bring all equipment to room E210 and choose set up area. Wax pots are to be plugged in night of registration.

Manicure including massage

Objective: To perform a basic manicure with massage. Shape free edge to nail plate shape. Apply base coat and two coats of colored polish and topcoat with no color bleeding.

Items to be supplied by competitor:

Fingerbowl	cuticle solvent
Cuticle pusher	cuticle oil
massage lotion	nail polish remover
Orangewood sticks	Emery boards
Towels	Alcohol
colored polish	base coat
Cotton	Top coat

Overall Grading:

Professionalism

Sanitation (dispose any orangewood sticks etc.)

File nails into correct shape to models hands.

Polish 2 coats colored polish. No excess polish left over.

Time to complete 1 hr

Fantasy makeup application

Objective: Applying creativity to your knowledge of makeup artistry. Full makeup must be model, fantasy applied on chosen focus area.

Items to be supplied by competitor:

Foundation	Brushes
Loose powder	Makeup palette
Brow pencil/powder	Sponges
Mascara	Spatula
Eye colors	Client cape
Eyeliners	Hair clips
Lip color	Disposable mascara wands
Lip line	Additional accessories of choice (Ex glitters feather etc.)

Overall look of fantasy with color choice of entire makeup application

Pedicure

Objective: To perform complete pedicure removing any dry areas. Proper shaping of toenails and care of cuticles.

Items to be supplied by competitor

Footbath	towels
Foot soak	exfoliation (scrub)
Cuticle oil	toenail clippers
Alcohol	cotton
Orangewood sticks	wooden foot file
Massage lotion	Base coat
Top coat	colored polish

Overall grading

Sanitation

Toenail shape and clean under free edge

Massage (pressure,duration and speed)

Polish application, no access polish on cuticles or sidewalls

1 hour and 30 minutes to complete.
