PURPOSE OF THE CHALLENGE: to evaluate each competitor’s preparation for employment. Recognize outstanding students for there excellence and professionalism in the esthetics industry.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE TO BE TESTED:

Independently demonstrate the knowledge and ability of the mastery of esthetics.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

Competitor Must Provide:

White uniform, shoes and hose. (no open toed shoes)

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, SUPPLIES:

List of supplies needed is under each category

JUDGING CRITERIA:

Client professionalism:

Competitors must smile and greet models

Ensure clients comfort

No talking during any part of the competition

SANITATION:

Clean and sanitize work area, including all equipment and implements.

Garbage’s are to be emptied and discarded each competition.

Wash and sanitize hands before each competition. (In case of no sink available bring hand sanitizer)

Gloves are to be worn in certain parts of the competition

COMPETITORS PROFESSIONAL IMAGE:

Makeup: Suitable for daytime

Hair: tied back if length allows, otherwise kept back from face.

Clothing: White uniform, shoes and hose. (Shoes may not be opened toed)

Nails: neatly manicured (No artificial nails for sanitary reasons)

Jewelry: None is to be worn throughout the competition

Personal Hygiene: No perfumes are to be worn throughout the competition

ADDITIONAL NOTES:

ORIENTATION WILL BE FROM 8:30 – 9:00AM, FRIDAY MARCH 17, 2006, AT. All competitors are to bring all equipment to MARCA COLLEGE 228 – 21st Street East, Saskatoon, SK. and set up area. Wax pots are to be plugged in night of registration.

MANICURE WITH RED POLISH

OBJECTIVE: to perform a basic manicure. Examine hands and fingernails, shape free edge according to shape of nail plate. Apply base coat, 2 coats of matte red polish and top coat with no color bleeding.

OVERALL GRADING:

Professionalism

Sanitation (dispose of any orangewood sticks etc)

Functional Setup

Proper Manicure procedure (soaking, push back cuticles, etc.)

File nails into correct shape to models hands

Polish 2 coats matte red polish. No excess polish left around cuticle or side wall area's.

Promptness

Nail Polish remover is not to be used at any part of the competition

1 HOUR TO COMPLETE

HOT AND WARM WAX COMPETITION:

OBJECTIVE: to remove all hair for lower legs and under arms using two methods of waxing. Ensuring no hair and residue is left behind. Tweezing is not allowed any part of the competition. When waxing disease transmission is possible, therefore gloves must be worn at all times.
